Jute is almost entirely an Indian crop but it is cultivated on a large scale in Bangladesh, Pakistan, Brazil, Mexico, Japan, China, Argentina, Indonesia, Iran, etc. So great is its economic value that about four million farming families are engaged in the cultivation of jute in India. As

an industrial crop it is quite cheap and in importance it is only next to cotton. The things

made from jute are also eco-friendly.

Oute is used mainly for rough weaving. Various types of bags, wools, ropes, sacks and covers are made from jute. The superior, long and glossy fibres are used for making carpets, twine, curtains cloth, etc. Jute butts, i.e, short fibres and pieces from the lower ends of the stalks are used in paper making. The white stalks are used widely in rural areas as fuel and material for walling or fencing.
