4. Analyse the achievements of Washington Conference (1921-22). How far was it successful in resisting Japanese imperialism?
5. What role did Mustafa Kamal Pasha play in the establishment of the Turkish Republic after the Treaty of Sevres?
6. How did the Mandate System come into existence in the post war period? Explain the nature of British Mandate upon Iraq in this context.
7. Review the course of expansion by Japan in China between 1914 and 1932.
8. What were circumstances leading to the signing of Munich Pact (1938)? What was its impact on international affairs?
9. Do you think that the Spanish Civil War served as dress rehearsal for the World War II?
10. Analyse the context of the Pearl Harbor Attack (1941) with special reference to Japanese-American relations between the two world wars.
